The Berlin Short Film Festival kiezkieken takes its audience to a journey through Berlin districts and invites them to rediscover the city. kiezkieken offers a platform for an urban creative pool including workshops, guided city tours, film screenings and discussions as well as a forum for a lively, creative and open exchange.

The short film competition addresses everybody, no matter if “home-grown” or new in Berlin, if professional or amateur. The condition is to make a film that takes place in one of the chosen urban-districts. The deadline is the 15th August. The max. length is 30 minutes. The genre is free. In July there will be also film-workshops for beginners.

The festival will take place on four weekends in november (5th and 6th, 12th and 13th, 19th and 20th, 27th november 2011). The first three weekends will be dedicated to one of the localities each. Every festival-saturday there will be guided tours through the respective Kiez. On the festival-sundays there will be the screenings of the movies and the discussions with the film makers, representatives of cultural projects and local politicians. On the 27th will be the award.

The films will be shown in cultural centres on site. In this way, the audience can collect their own impressions about the respective district and compare them to those shown in the films. We take the road through the city, explore and discover it in a different way. We draw secrets and stories from the city. kiezkieken not only offers impressions into the Berlin city life, it also makes us aware of how we perceive our environment. kiezkieken is dedicated to the transformations to which city life is permanently subjected.
